Digital Innovation Hubs in Lithuania



Now there are 7 DIHs and 3 EDIHs.

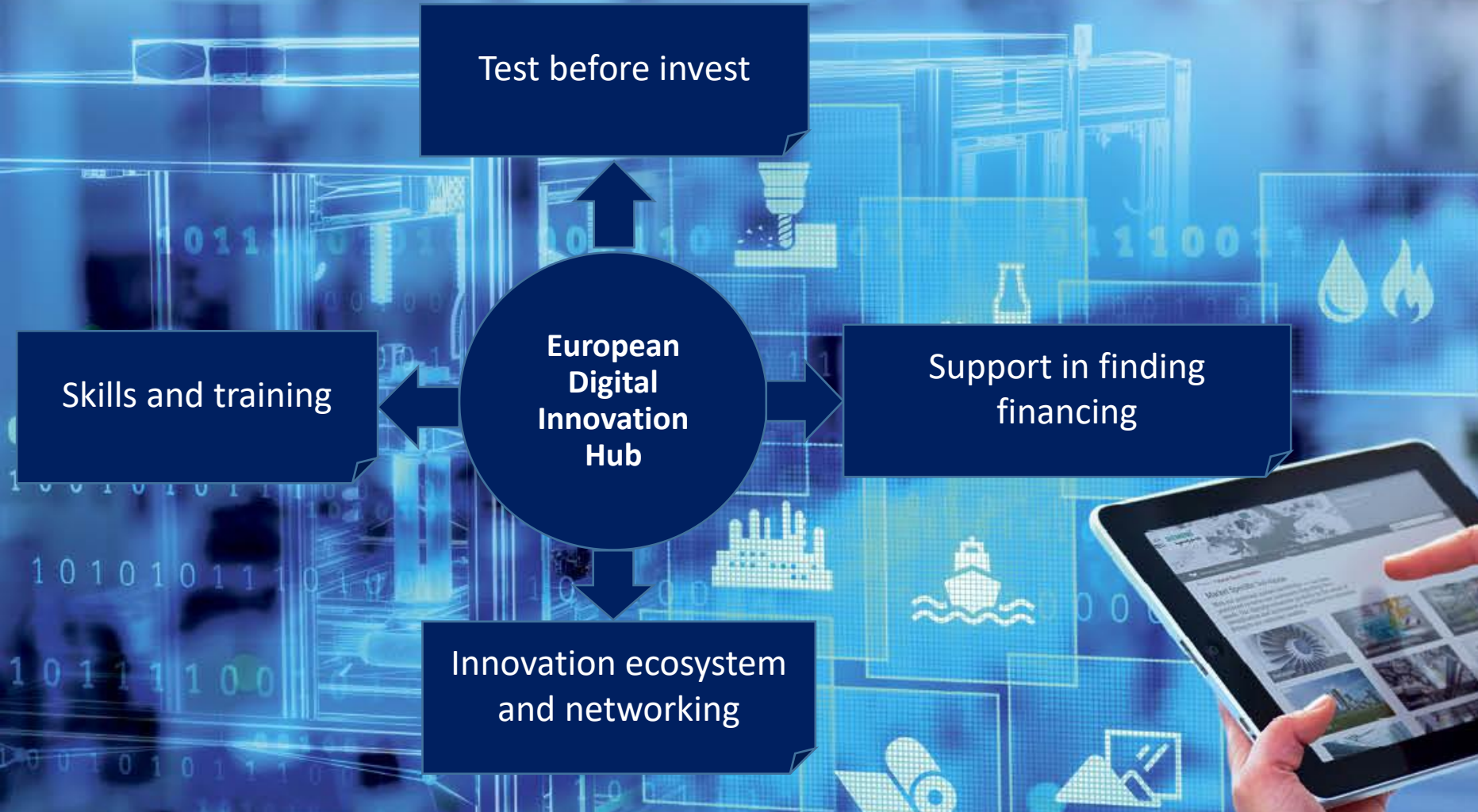
The DIHs provide companies with services related to digital transformation and are the innovation mediators, offering access to test and experiment infrastructure:

- Digitalisation of services and processes
- Involvement of companies into European Value Chains
- Circular Economy

What is a European Digital Innovation Hub?



A European Digital Innovation Hub (EDIH) is a single organisation or a coordinated group of organisations with complementary expertise, with a not-for-profit objective that support companies – especially SMEs and mid-caps – and/or the public sector in their digital transformation.

EDIH Selection in Lithuania



Carried out in accordance with the requirements described in the European Commission's working document "European Digital Innovation Hubs in the Digital Europe Programme through a transparent, open and competitive selection process

After the National selection round a shortlist of 3 candidates was provided to the European Commission, which was later confirmed by independent experts: the proposals of all 3 candidates from Lithuania were above the selection threshold

EDIH Selection in Lithuania (COMPETENCES)



1. At least one digital competence, supported by the „Digital Europe Programme“:
 - High Power Computing
 - Cyber security
 - **Artificial Intelligence**
2. At least 10 percent of EDIH services to be provided to **Public sector** organisations
3. Services based on **Smart Specialisation Strategies**
4. Implementation of **Green industry** policy requirements

EDIH Selection in Lithuania (FINANCING)



50% of the funding of EDIHs is provided by the Digital Europe Programme, and the other 50% is provided by the Member States and/ or their regions.

The budget for Lithuania (for the first 3 years) from DIGITAL EUROPE PROGRAMME: M 4, 857 EUR.

Industry 4.0 Lab – M 3.5 EUR (RRF)
