






### What is an EDIH?



### European Digital Innovation Hubs,

- ..aim to support the <u>digital and green transformation</u> of <u>companies</u> (especially SMEs and small Mid-caps) and / or <u>public sector</u> organisations on a large scale
- ..consist of <u>one or more organization(s)</u> working together and complementing each other's expertise
- ..serve a defined geographical area, providing support to customers within an area that allows
  companies to visit the EDIH within a reasonable travelling time
- ..can operate in a variety of <u>technologies</u> & <u>sectors</u>: AI, Big Data, Cybersecurity, Energy, Water, Agriculture, Food Processing, Manufacturing, Health, Transport, Life Science, Maritime, etc.
- ..typically consist of Research and Technology Organisations, Universities, Sectoral Associations/ Chambers of Commerce & Industry, Clusters, EEN, Accelerators/Incubators, Regional development or Innovation agencies, Innovative SME, Municipalities, etc.

### What is an EDIH?



- An EDIH.. should provide services in the following areas:
- <u>Test before invest</u>: providing facilities, infrastructure and support to enable clients to test digital technologies in order to make an informed decision about investments in digital technologies
- <u>Skills and training</u>: providing services and offers to upskill the clients' existing labor force, as well as to increase the overall competencies in companies and / or public sector organisations and establish a strategic perspective in leading company positions with regard to digital transformation
- <u>Support to find investment</u>: helping clients to find sources of funding for their digital transformation investments as well as for new digital services and business models
- <u>Networking and access to innovation ecosystems</u>: to establish a network of support in its area as well as to build and provide access to relevant innovation ecosystems. The EDIH will need to establish a regional network and be part of a Europe-wide network, also to provide a one-stop-shop for customers. This explicitly includes networking with other EDIHs as well as other projects funded by the Digital Europe Programme (DEP).

## **EDIH Budget and its distribution**



### Funding of total budget:


- Up to 50% funded through Digital Europe Programme (4.5M € for Ukraine provided by the EC) (can also be used to serve EU-MS clients, Export Promotion of UA services)
- 50% own contribution from Ukraine applicant: Sponsorship by international donors, Governmental funding, funds of consortia members, income generated through the EDIH services as well as a mixture of funding sources (for EoI/CfP important to have an idea, not budget right away available! see also EDIH FAQ Manual)
- For example, total budget of 500.000 EUR: 250.000 EUR by the EC, 250.000 EUR by the applicant

What are the typical ranges going to personnel costs, equipment/facilities, travel, events, etc.?

- Each EDIH decides the budget distribution on equipment/ facilities, personnel costs, etc., depending on its specific circumstances (and depending on its service offers)
- The Commission therefore does not want to put any hard constraints in the form of typical ranges for expenditure
